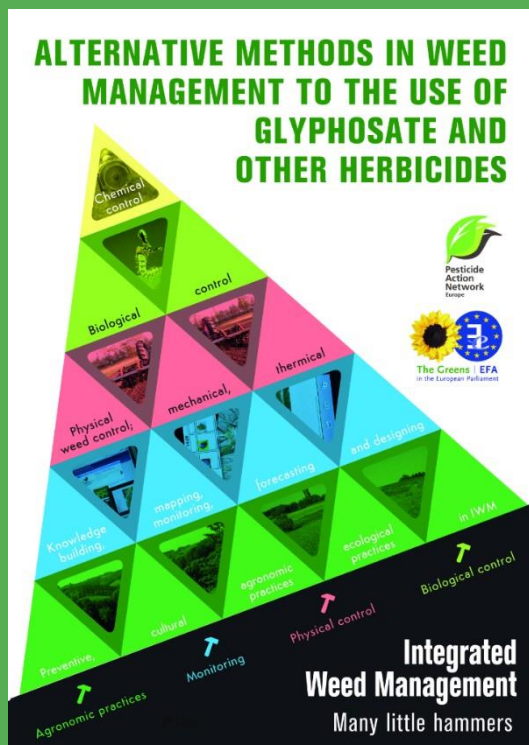

SAVE THE BEES: A historic moment for the bees! Member States have finally backed the proposal from the European Commission to ban all outdoor uses of 3 bee-killing neonicotinoids. [Read more here>>](#)

It has been published as a contribution to the ongoing discussions among some Member States, led by France, on phasing out glyphosate and promoting alternatives.
